The Alpin Corner has always met with great interest in recent years. Hopefully, thanks to the support of many spotlights, we will be able to present current and first-class finds again this year.


For big and small visitors there is an active competition and accompanied stone processing with beautiful minerals and fossils to choose and keep for yourself.

1.	Place Registration	Registrations received after the registration deadline can only be considered if there are still

2.	Reservation expiry	Reservations that have not been paid within 30 days of receipt of the invoice will expire after a single reminder.				
3.	Allocation of space	This is based on the quality of the exhibits. Minerals and fossils have priority, as do unset

4.	Stone jewelry Ornaments	Approved if the proportion of stone is dominant and the production is of an artisanal nature and of impeccable quality				
5.	Material declaration					
		contain the following information:				
		for Minerals: Correct mineral name (internationally recognized) Origin / locality, price				
		for any ground Correct mineral name or designation according to the current CIBJO				
		material standard, also genuine / natural or reconstructed or doublet or triplet,				
		Metal content in origin / locality, price, company. Misleading fancy names are strictly

		fossils, mounted minerals/fossils, products from irradiation processes, recent shells and corals				
		(foam corals), pearls, ivory, as well as pure souvenir items and objects from mass production,				
		objects without mineral content and reference to a mineral show, gemstone imitations,				
		recolored objects. Crystals with artificial surfaces added by subsequent cutting. Cult and occult				
		objects, as well as purely esoteric material. Bath and food salts (e.g. also Himalayan salt) Flower vases and the like with less than 50% minerals/fossils				
		The range of healing stones is subject to certain restrictions, e.g. pronounced massage stones				
		or other objects of a non-exhibition aspect are excluded from sale. Mineral preparations in the				
		form of ointments and for oral application are also prohibited. The material declaration
